(b) **Studies in Arts (96 points)** including:

Discipline A#: **Major** Arts sequence (48pts) — Any one of: Ancient History, Anthropology, Behavioural Studies, Drama, English, Geography, History, Jewish Studies, LOTE**, Music, Politics, Psychology, or Sociology.

Discipline B*: **Minor** Arts sequence (24pts) — Any one of: Anthropology, Behavioural Studies, Drama, English, Geography, History, Jewish Studies, Linguistics, Politics, Psychology, or Sociology

Discipline C**: 1st yr Arts sequence (12pts) — Selection of another teaching area is recommended

Discipline D***: Further 12 Arts points — May be selected from discipline A, B, C at first or 2nd year level, or Discipline D at 1st or 2nd year level.

3) Please consult Course Advisor or Course Administrator to ensure you have correct prerequisites to continue in a LOTE sequence.
