NOTE: ELIGIBILITY FOR GRADUATION: To be eligible to graduate from the course students must have:

- Completed a minimum of 80 days of satisfactory professional placement.
- Physical Education method – a current Level 2 First Aid qualification **and/OR** a Remote Area First Aid qualification + a current AUSTSWIM Teacher of Water Safety Certificate.
- Outdoor Education method – a current Remote Area First Aid qualification, plus registered Aquatic Certificate (eg: AUSTSWIM, Bronze) is required.

In order that students may qualify to teach Physical Education outside of Victoria, students should check requirements with their local authority.
