Note :

- To be eligible to graduate from the course students must have completed a minimum of 80 days of satisfactory teaching practice.
- To receive the awards of Bachelor of Visual Arts and Bachelor of Education, a student must successfully complete units totalling **204** points, consisting of:

(a) Studies in Education (108 points) including a series of units relating to the theory and practice of education, teaching and curriculum. (b) Studies in Visual Arts (96 points) including:

(i) Discipline Major **Visual Arts Studio** — This is a major core study of 60pts, comprising 12pts at year one level and at least 36pts at year two and three level. Students select one of the following major studies:

Glass studio, interdisciplinary design studio, metals/jewellery studio, painting studio, photomedia studio, printmedia studio, sculpture studio, or theory of art & design*. (* if combined with 12pts of studio art [practical]).

(ii) **** Students in first year** Visual Arts must be **concurrently enrolled in OHS1000** (0 credit points), which is a **compulsory** unit in all Visual Arts degrees and must be completed in first semester, first year.
