- #BBusCom Major definitions:
 - A major of eight units (48 pts)
 - The major must come from the approved list of majors offered in the Bachelor of Business and Commerce
 - At least two units (12 pts) must be completed at each of second and third year levels
 - Additional units from the faculty in the Bachelor of Business and Commerce to reach the required minimum of 16 units (96 pts).
Additional degree requirements:
 - a maximum of 8 first-year level units (48 pts) from the Faculty of Business and Economics
 - a minimum of 4 third-year level units (24 pts) from the Faculty of Business and Economics.
- Studies in education (96 points), a series of units relating to the theory and practice of education, teaching and curriculum. Fieldwork placements are also included.
